School Supplies

Early Childhood Education

•backpack/book bag, 1 large (175-200 count) box of tissues, one package of napkins, refill pack or box of wipes for projects.

Poynette Kindergarten

•box of crayons (24 count), 1 box washable markers (8 count), 3 glue sticks (1 oz. or larger), large bookbag, 1 pair blunt (Fiskars) scissors, paint shirt (large, short-sleeved t-shirt is great), 1 folder for take-home papers, 1 folder with brass fastener insert with pockets, 1 large package of napkins and 1 large box of tissues, 1 box (10-15) gallon size Ziploc bages from students whose last names begin with A-M, 1 medium size school (Elmer's) glue from students whose last names begin with N-Z, Kindermat (red/blue)—thin folding plastic covered resting mat, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. Most supplies will be used by the entire class so you only need to label the resting mat, back pack/bookbag, art shirt, folders, and coloring book.

Arlington Kindergarten

•1 large bookbag/backpack, 8 small glue sticks, 3 folders (the kind with pictures on them are sturdier than paper ones), 1 box of 24 crayons, 8-12 pencils, 1 bottle hand sanitizer, 1 resting mat (no sleeping bags, please), 1 coloring book, 1 pkg. of napkins, 1 box sandwich size Ziploc baggies or 1 package paper plates, 1 old t-shirt to be used as an art smock (no buttons please), 1 box markers (wide or narrow), Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. Most supplies will be used by the entire class so you only need to label the resting mat, backpack/bookbag, art shirt, folders, and coloring book.

Dekorra Kindergarten

•a restmat-preferably thin, folding and plastic covered, backpack/bag large enough to carry a folder to and from school, 1 box of One-Zip freezer plastic bags— boys buy quart size and girls buy gallon size, 1 large box of kleenex, 1 roll of paper towels, 4 large glue sticks, 1 box of crayons, 1 two-pocket folder (the kind with pictures on them are studier than the paper folders), 1 pair of child's (Fiskar) scissors, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. Most supplies will be used by the entire class so you only need to label the resting mat, backpack/bookbag, crayons, folder, and scissors.

Poynette 1st Grade

•plastic school supply box, crayons, large (Elmer's) glue, 8 large glue sticks, 1 pair of pointed scissors, pkg. of markers, 2 yellow highlighters, 2 erasers, 2 boxes of pencils (30 #2 sharpened, if possible), colored pencils (labeled individually), 1 large box of tissues, bookbag or backpack, coloring book, 4 pocket-style (plastic if possible) folders (1 blue and 1 yellow or orange with fasteners; 1 green & 1 red without fasteners), 1 wide-ruled spiral notebook, 1 plain drawing tablet, 1 old magazine, 1 deck of cards, 1 box of Ziploc sandwich size bags, tennis shoes for physical education class, 1 box of Ziploc gallon size bags, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. Please label the bookbag, crayons, folder and scissors.

Arlington 1st Grade

•1 backpack, 1 school box to hold school supplies, 30 #2 pencils (sharpened if possible & made in the U.S.A.), 2 large erasers, 1 box of crayons, 1 package of colored pencils, 3 wide-ruled spiral notebook, 4 plain pocket folders (2 green), 1 large bottle of (Elmer's) glue, 6 glue sticks, 1 pair of blunt scissors, 1 box One Zip storage bags (gallon size), 25 Ziploc sandwich bags, 1 deck of cards, 100 large white paper plates from students whose last names begin with A-R, 1 package of plastic spoons from students whose last names begin with S-Z, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. *Please label everything.*

Dekorra 1st Grade

•1 backpack, 1 school box to hold school supplies, 1 pair of scissors, 30 #2 pencils (sharpened if possible), 2 large erasers, 1 box of crayons, 1 package of colored pencils, 6 wide-ruled spiral notebooks, 6 plain pocket folders, 1 plain drawing tablet, 4 glue sticks, 2 large boxes of tissues, 1 box Hefty One-Zip storage bags (gallon size), 1 ruler (inch/metric), 1 deck of cards, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. *Please label everything.*

Poynette and Dekorra 2nd Grade

•school supply box, box of crayons, 2 packages of 10 (#2) pencils (sharpened), 2 large erasers, 1 pkg. pencil-top erasers, pointed scissors, Scotch tape, large glue, 4 glue sticks, markers, colored pencils, pink highlighter marker, bookbag, 1 pkg. wide-ruled loose leaf paper (100 count), 4 pocket folders (one must be red), 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks, 12" WOODEN ruler with inches and centimeters, 1 large box of tissues, 1 deck of 52 playing cards, 1 box Hefty One-Zip storage bags (quart or gallon size), bag of money (30 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes, and 10 quarters), tennis shoes, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. *Please label everything.*

Arlington 2nd Grade

•1 large white glue, 3 large glue sticks, 1 box of 24 count crayons, box of colored pencils, 30 #2 pencils to be shared in classroom, 2 large erasers (Pink Pearl work well), 1 wide-ruled notebooks, 1-3-pronged bottom pocket folders, 3 plain bottom-pocket folders, Scotch tape, small box for supplies, bookbag, 1 pair of jersey gloves to be used in the school garden, tennis shoes, Texas Instrument-108 calculator—see *box on page 12*. *Please label everything.*



Poynette 3rd Grade

•small school supply box, 2 glue sticks, pointed scissors, box of crayons, colored pencils, 2 large erasers, 12" ruler with both inches and centimeters, 2 pens of any color, 2 pkgs. of sharpened #2 pencils, 1 pkg. of wide-ruled loose leaf paper, 6 inexpensive pocket folders, 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks, 1 1/2" binder with a clear plastic front pocket, box of Zip-Lock bags (quart or gallon size), large box (200 count) of tissues, bag of money (for math)--30 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes, and 10 quarters, a disposable camera, tennis shoes, swim suit and towel for physical education class, Texas Instrument-108 or 30XA calculator--see box below. ***Please label everything.**

Arlington 3rd Grade

•book bag, small school supply box, 2 packages of #2 pencils (sharpened if possible), inch/metric ruler with 1/4 and 1/2 inches marked, colored pencils, crayons, fine markers (optional), 2 large erasers, pointed scissors, 2 large glue sticks, 1 highlighter marker, 1 pair of gardening gloves, 3 wide-ruled spiral notebooks, 6 pocket folders, 1 bag of money (for math – real or plastic) – 30 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes & 10 quarters, a wide dry erase marker, 1 pkg. of wide-ruled loose leaf paper, 1 disposable camera, 1 box of Zip-Lock bags (quart or pint size), Texas Instrument-108 or 30XA calculator--see box below. ***Please label everything.**

Dekorra 3rd Grade

•book bag, small school supply box, 1 highlighter marker (yellow), 2 pkgs. of #2 lead pencils (sharpened, if possible), 1 red pen, 1 large glue stick, 1 large bottle of Elmer's glue, 1 pair of pointed scissors, 1 large box of crayons, 2 large erasers, 1 pkg. of pencil top erasers, 6 pocket folders, 3 wide-ruled spiral notebooks (single subject), 12 inch/metric ruler, 1 pkg. wide-lined loose leaf paper, 2 boxes of 200-count tissues, 1 box of Zip-Lock bags (quart or gallon), 1 bag of money (for math – real or plastic) – 30 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes & 10 quarters, 1 disposable camera, Texas Instrument-108 or 30XA calculator--see box below. *Optional: Scotch tape, markers, colored pencils.*

Poynette 4th Grade

•red pencil or pen, 12 inch/metric ruler, 4 glue sticks, scissors, large eraser, crayons, colored pencils, pkg. of #2 pencils, small supply box, 4 pocket folders, 4 wide-ruled spiral notebooks, 1" binder with a clear cover sleeve and 2 interior pockets, 1 pkg. of wide-ruled loose leaf paper, 1 pkg. of 3" x 3" Post-It notes, 1 large box of tissues, markers (optional), Texas Instrument-30XA calculator--see box below. **No Trapper Keepers.**

Poynette 5th Grade

•#2 pencils, colored pencils, markers, 1 highlighter, 2 erasable pens, 1 ruler, pencil box, large eraser, 4 wide-ruled spiral notebooks, 1 pkg. loose leaf paper, 4 folders, 1 one-inch three-ring binder (if possible reuse fourth grade binder), 2 glue sticks, 1 pair scissors, 1 box of tissues, 1 scientific calculator (Texas Instrument's TI 30 for example, solar if possible), (optional: deck of playing cards). **No Trapper Keepers.**

For All Elementary Students

- **NO TRAPPER-KEEPERS** – NO "trapper-keepers" in school because of limited space in the desks.
- **CALCULATORS** – all grades K-5 students will make use of calculators in their math classes next year. We would like all students to have the same calculators for learning purposes. If you do not have the opportunity to purchase the recommended calculator, the school will supply them at an approximate cost of \$5.25 for the TI-108 (for grades K-3 students), and \$10.00 for the Texas Instrument-30XA calculator (for grades 4-5 students). *If your child is entering grade 3, you may use or purchase either type of calculator.* A letter will go out to parents during the first week of school with additional information about the calculators and their prices.

•please bring 2 pencils to be kept in the art room.

•Grades 2-5 participate in swimming as part of the physical education class. Swim suit and towel is needed (not on first day of school).

Immunization Schedule

The revised Wisconsin State Immunization law requires most incoming kindergarten students to have had the following immunizations: 5 DPT, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, 3 Hepatitis B, and 2 Varicella or a history of chicken pox.

Students in grades 6, 9 and 12 will need a Tdap booster. 6th and 12th grades are required to have a second varicella unless they have a history of having chicken pox.

Please have your doctor send or FAX (635-9233) the immunization dates to the school nurse's office. A complete date of month, day and year is needed.

For a schedule of free immunizations clinics available at the Columbia County Health Dept., please call 742-9227.

If you, as the parent/guardian, feel that you do not wish to immunize your child, a waiver form must be signed. These forms can be obtained from the school nurse, the office secretaries or from the school web site.

The United Healthcare Children's Foundation has health care grants to help low income families with insurance to pay for medical costs not covered by their commercial insurance. This grant is not available to Medicaid or SCHIP recipients. Their web site is: <http://uhccp.org>.

Poynette Middle School – Grades 6th to 8th

The items listed below are recommended for purchase in addition to the usual school supplies such as spiral notebooks for each subject, pens, pencils, etc. Throughout the year, middle school students generally use 6-8 notebooks or the equivalent (1 needs to be wide-ruled), 8 pocket folders (these are optional but helpful for organizing), loose leaf paper, a Trapper-Keeper or other organizer.

- **A Texas Instrument-30XA calculator is required for all middle school students.** If you have not purchased one, you may do so through the school for approximately \$10.
- **6th graders** will need a 1" binder with pockets, 1 pkg. of loose leaf paper, colored pencils, and a composition notebook for Communication Arts, pencils, and 1 folder for each academic class (4). A thick, 5-subject notebook with a sturdy cover (plastic) is needed for Science. A notebook is needed for Social Studies.
- **7th graders** will need 2 packs of loose leaf paper, 1 standard notebook, 1 composition notebook, colored pencils, 1 package of 3x5 inch lined notecards, 2 highlighters (different colors), 2 glue sticks, black pens, *at least* a dozen pencils, a large box of Kleenex, a 1" 3-ring binder with a clear front pocket (black) for Science, a 1 1/2" 3-ring binder with a clear front pocket (white) and a set of 5-tab dividers for Math, a 1 1/2" 3-ring binder with dividers and pockets (blue) for Social Studies, a 1 1/2" 3-ring binder with dividers and pockets (white) for Communication Arts, we also suggest that students label materials with first and last names to avoid conflict and confusion. A folder is needed for Spanish class.
- **8th graders** will need loose leaf paper & a folder for Communication Arts. Social Studies will require one notebook per semester and pens. For 8th grade Math, students will need one 3-ring binder, 5 dividers for the binder and 3-hole punched loose leaf paper. A notebook and folder will be needed for 8th grade Health. A folder is needed for Spanish class.
- **7th & 8th grader Choir** students will need black pants/skirts and a plain white shirt (no writing on clothing) for concert attire.
- **7th & 8th grader General Music** students will need a pocket folder, a spiral notebook and a pencil.
- **6th, 7th & 8th grade Physical Education** students will need clothes for activity, tennis shoes, swim suit and towel.
- **6th, 7th & 8th grade Family & Consumer Sciences** students will need a packet of loose leaf paper as well as a folder and pencil.
- **6th, 7th & 8th grade Art** students will need 2 pencils each and color pencils.

Use of Backpacks – Grades 6-12 students will be able to use backpacks to bring books and supplies to and from school, however, the bags must stay in their lockers during the school day. This decision was made for health, safety and security reasons.

Poynette High School – Grades 9th to 12th

The items listed below are recommended for purchase in addition to the usual school supplies such as spiral notebooks for each subject, pens, pencils, etc.

- **Anatomy & Biology**
-dissecting gloves (or a pair of dishwashing gloves)
- **Art/Photo/Commercial Graphics**
-bring in a small picture of yourself for photo ID and old t-shirts are needed
- **Band** (*Available through band director) *renting a school-owned instrument-\$25, *(Wind Instruments only)–Instrumental Methods book for \$7, *dry-cleaning fee for concert uniform-\$5, *dry-cleaning fee for marching band uniform-\$5.
- **Business Classes**
(Consumer Business & Accounting)
-hand-held calculator
- **Business Information Technology**
-box of tissues
- **Choir**
-will need black pants or skirt and a black top for performances.

- **Conservation Ecology**
-a copy of Sand County Almanac by Aldo Leopold.
- **English for Grades 9-12**
-2 notebooks (1 spiral), loose leaf paper for assignments, 1-2 pocket folders. Assignments must be done in black or blue ink–no florescent pens.
- **Math**
-AP Calculus & Pre-Calculus (also Algebra 2 students planning on taking these courses) need a Graphing Calculator (Texas Instruments) TI-84 Plus, TI-84 Plus Silver Edition or TI-83 Plus.
-Probability & Statistics, Integrated Math Courses (Intro, Integrated Math1, & 3) & Computer Science also need a Graphing Calculator, as above.
- **Photography**
-photo IDs will be required to check out class materials (bring a photo of yourself). Provisions will be made until the 2009-20010 IDs are distributed.

- **Physical Education**
-high school physical education classes will need a complete change of clothes (sweat pants or wind pants, shorts, t-shirts, sweatshirt)
-also need sneakers/athletic shoes
-duffle bag or backpack
-locker room lock (needs to be purchased at the school office for \$5; money is refundable upon return).
-a separate pair of shoes/sneakers will be required for curling units.
- **Post-Secondary Planning**
-pocket folder
- **Science 9, Chemistry & Advanced Chemistry**
-scientific calculator
- **Technology Education**
-wood for individual projects (Woods Manufacturing), and a 1" x 8" oak board 3 feet long (General Technology)
