The Board of Education conducted a regular Board meeting on Monday, September 26, 2011. The meeting was held in the High School IMC. The following agenda items were addressed:

1. Two candidates, Jeff Noble and Chris David, interviewed for the vacant seat on the Board of Education.
2. Jeff Noble was elected to the board on the second ballot by a 4-2 vote.
3. Reports were presented by Matt Shappell, Brian Sutton and Alan Chittick.
4. The Board met with three representatives from the Riteway Bus Service Company to review the logistics of the bus routes and to consider cost saving measures.
5. Matt Shappell, High School Principal, presented a recommendation for supervising the swimming pool and encouraging community use of the pool.
6. The Board acknowledged three Special Education Aide resignations and the hiring of three Special Education Aides and a Driver for the 4-K Van.
7. The Board acknowledged the hiring of Bob Tomlinson as the Varsity Girls Softball Coach for the 2012 season.
8. Matt Shappell reported on the South Central Conference's efforts to add Lodi and Poynette to their conference.
9. Matt Shappell encouraged the Board of Education to pass a motion against joining the South Central Conference. The Board will consider this motion at its October 10th meeting.
10. The Board created two new Committees- Policy/Finance and Curriculum. The Board retained the Facilities Committee.
11. The Board members selected the Committee they wished to serve and will select the date of their monthly meeting.
12. The Board adjourned into Executive Session where it addressed the terms of the sale of the Dekorra School Site and Administrative Contracts.
13. The Board reconvened into open session where it set the terms for the sale of the Dekorra School Site to the Town of Dekorra.
14. The meeting adjourned at approximately 10:00 P.M.
