November 29, 2017 Committee Meeting Update

The Community Facility Advisory Committee (Committee) toured the High School with Dr. Hoernke, Principal and Mrs. McCracken, Associate Principal/Athletic Director. Both Administrators shared staff feedback about some of the challenges and benefits of the spaces.

After the tour, the Committee broke into groups to confirm district-wide needs and develop potential solutions/options that would address district-wide facility needs. The Committee came up with several options and ideas for Plunkett Raysich Architects and J.H. Findorff & Son Inc. to further explore.

Several themes about the High School were discussed:

- Lack of or undersized space(s)
 - Presentation/group projects/performance area
 - STE(A)M (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art/Agriculture, and Math)
 - Collaboration areas
 - Weight room
 - Cafeteria
- Limited ADA accessibility
- Lack of secure entrance
- Interior/exterior site or layout issues
