# COMMUNITY FACILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE AGENDA & UPDATE

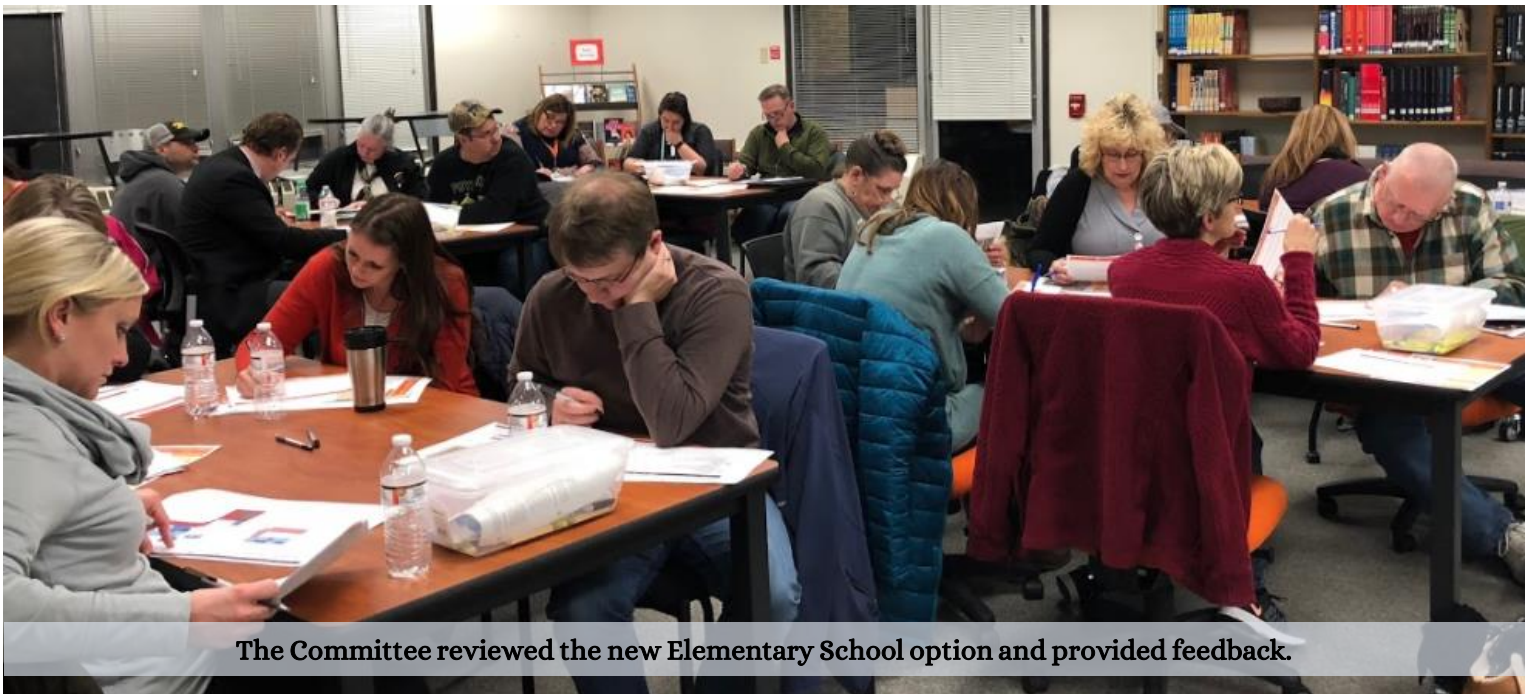
*January 24, 2018*

The Community Facility Advisory Committee (Committee) meeting focused on the facility-planning process, community-survey strategy, and prioritizing the Elementary School option the Committee voted to continue exploring further at the last meeting.

The Committee reviewed updated plans of potential renovations, additions, and new construction. Afterward, table discussions took place to determine what projects are the highest priority. The group next reported out its thoughts on prioritization. The Committee gave direction to the District, School Board, and consultants that the following items are the most important areas to address.

- Improving safety and security
- Addressing District-wide facility maintenance
- Creating flexible learning and teaching environments
- Improving parking and traffic issues
- Renovating spaces for Science, Technology, Engineering, Agriculture/Art, and Math (STEAM) programming.
