January 10, 2018 Committee Meeting Update

The Community Facility Advisory Committee (Committee) meeting focused on narrowing the updated and refined options, and reviewing three new options proposed from the last meeting.

For the first time, the Committee reviewed costs associated with all seven options. After both group and table discussion to weigh the pros and cons of each option and costs, the Committee voted on whether an option should or should not continue to be explored.

After the votes were tallied, the New Elementary School Path | Option 2b was the only proposed option that would be further explored. One hundred percent of the Committee members supported this option moving forward.

The Committee will begin prioritizing this option at their next meeting in order to refine it further.
