## **November 1, 2017 Committee Meeting Update**

The Community Facility Advisory Committee (Committee) toured Arlington Early Learning Center to better understand the building's condition. Part of the group's learning included hearing about the Facility Assessment that was performed earlier this year by J.H. Findorff & Son Inc (Findorff). Ben Austin, Findorff Project Manager, gave the Committee cost information and details surrounding the capital maintenance needs at each building.

Ken Turba, an Architect with Plunkett Raysich Architects, provided information about current enrollment numbers, and maximum and optimal capacity analysis for each building.

Several strong themes about Arlington were discussed:

- Undersized spaces or lack of instructional spaces
- Concerns about the age & costs to maintain building/building systems
- Safety & security upgrades needed
- Loss of instructional time
- Inefficiencies with staff and resources

Additional areas that were discussed included understanding Poynette's enrollment and capacity and how that impacts instruction.
