The Board of Education conducted a regular Board meeting on Monday, November 14, 2011. The meeting was held in the High School IMC. The following agenda items were addressed:

1. Reports were presented by Brian Sutton, Elementary School Principal, Matt Shappell, High School Principal, and Nancy Mair, Business Manager.
2. Kathleen Lucey and Richard Wilkinson presented an overview of the Curriculum Committee meeting held on November 11, 2011.
3. Three representatives from GO-RITEWAY Transportation Group presented a Common School Starting time transportation option for the 2012-13 school year.
4. Jay Hausser, Associate Elementary Principal and Jerry Pritzl, High School Associate Principal, presented an overview of the Puma Pride Programs being implemented in the Elementary and High School during the 2011-12 school year.
5. The Board and Administration previewed the three meetings scheduled with the representatives from Honeywell/ESG on Tuesday and Thursday of this week.
6. The Board accepted the resignation of High School custodian Mickey Nauert.
7. The Board approved the custodial staffing structure recommended by the administration.
8. The Board accepted the resignation of Vocational Agriculture teacher Steven Koss.
9. The Board approved the application for early graduation from five members of the Senior Class.
10. Matt Shappell presented an overview of the report submitted by the Block Scheduling Committee.
11. The Board accepted an anonymous donation of money to help finance curriculum materials for the 8th grade program.
12. The Board appointed Kathleen Lucey to serve as the delegate to the WASB Delegate Assembly scheduled for January 17, 2012.
13. The Board adjourned into executive session to address collective bargaining considerations.
