October 4, 2017 Committee Meeting Update

The Community Facility Advisory Committee (Committee) began the visioning phase of the facilities planning process by hearing Plunkett Raysich Architect's (PRA) presentation about modern learning environments and nation-wide school trends.

The Committee was asked to think about what inspired them and how Poynette's facilities could better support teaching and learning.

After seeing examples of modern learning environments, several themes emerged from the open discussion:

- Collaborative learning environments impact how students learn and teachers teach
- Flexible spaces and furniture can transform learning environments
- Students need problem solving and 21st Century skills to remain competitive post-high school
- ... and several others that included collaborative, larger, and flexible spaces
