### PRESS RELEASE

The Board of Education conducted a regular Board Meeting on Monday, April 23, 2012. The meeting was held in the High School IMC. The following agenda items were addressed:

1. The Board voted to retain the same officers for the upcoming year: President- Kathleen Lucey; Vice- President- Randy Hoffmann; Clerk - Richard Wilkinson and Treasurer- Greg Scherneckner.
2. Bridget Skaar presented the student report indicating that the Advanced Placement Exams are scheduled in two weeks; the conservation club participated in the clean up day and there are twenty-eight days remaining in the 2011-12 school year.
3. The administrative reports included the calendaring of interviews of the candidates for the High School Principal position. They are tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, May 15th.
4. The Board reports included an overview of the Curriculum Committee meeting by Kathleen Lucey and Richard Wilikinson; the Facilities Committee by Randy Tomlinson and the Policy/Finance Committee by Greg Scherneckner.
5. The Board passed the second reading of Board Policy - English Language Learners
6. Updates were provided for the Referendum Construction Project and the Guaranteed Energy Savings Project.
7. Pupil Services Director- Alan Chittick- presented an overview of the Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts standardized tests.
8. The Board election results were reviewed. Richard Wilkinson ran as a write in candidate and will serve a two year term. Greg Scherneckner, Jeff Noble and Kathleen Lucey will serve three year terms.
9. The Board approved a modification of the last scheduled student day- Thursday, June 7th  
The 8th graders will not attend school on June 7th and all of the other students will be dismissed at 12:30 P.M. All bus students will depart at the same time- 12:30 P.M.
10. Greg Scherneckner was elected to serve as the delegate to the CESA 5 Convention that will be held on Thursday, May 17th.
11. The board accepted the resignation of Patricia Heinzmann from the Varsity Girls BB coaching position contingent upon filling the position with a qualified replacement.
12. The Board accepted the resignation of Brian Visger from the JV Girls BB coaching position contingent upon filling the position with a qualified replacement.
